FLIPPED-MASTERY

A flipped class turns the traditional structure upside down. As homework, students take Cornell notes from lectures stored on the class website. The skill development normally associated with homework is done in class.

In a mastery class, students learn a series of lessons at their own pace. Students demonstrate mastery of a lesson's themes and thinking skills on a summative assessment. For students who do not master a lesson, remediation is provided and the student is given another assessment. Those who do master move on to the next lesson.
